THE MUSIC PROGRAM

You can gaze into a crystal ball to try to determine the music of the future — or you can head over to the Schenectady Museum to hear (and see) what it looks like. As part of its ongoing Edison Media Project, the museum hosts the Capital Region premiere of TransPose, a futuristic electronic musical instrument that's been developed by the digital arts collective FeedTank. The performer's silhouette is projected in front of them along with noteboxes, which produce a sound when touched. The performer can change between instruments and record loops that can be turned on or off to create layered compositions. Performing on TransPose will be Shelley Burgon, harpist with the Brooklyn-based experimental indie band Stars Like Fleas. **2 p.m. Saturday.
